

APPENDIX H GLOSSARY OF TERMS

- **Accessible:**
- **Activities:** Services provided
- **Appropriate:** Services should be appropriate to the target population, relative to culture, gender, age, cognitive development, other special needs, etc.
- **Benchmarks:** Performance data used to gauge future performance
- **Community-based services:** These services include programs such as relief nurseries, family support programs, and parent education programs
- **Community Mapping:** Picture of prevailing community conditions (strengths) that contribute to wellness and of needs to be met
- **Goals:** Overall statements of well-being
- **Inputs:** Resources used to provide activities
- **Outputs:** Products of activities
 - Helps produce outcomes
 - Example: number of participants, or classes
- **Outcomes:** Change in attitude, behavior, condition, knowledge, or status
 - **Intermediate outcomes:** links to long-term change
 - ❖ Related to initial outcomes
 - ❖ Change in behavior resulting from knowledge, attitude or skill
 - **High-level outcomes:** desired achievements
 - ❖ Builds on intermediate outcomes
 - ❖ Meaningful change in condition or status
- **Outcome indicators:** Specific data to track outcomes
- **Outcome targets:** Expected levels of program achievements
- **Priorities:** Express community's preference for areas in which to focus efforts
- **Strategies:**
 - Reflect reasoned and supportable approach to priorities
 - Inputs and activities used to produce outputs and outcomes
- **Targets:** Desired output or outcome over time
