

## Notice – LaneCare Omsbudperson

The Lane County Department of Health and Human Services is seeking letters of interest from qualified contractors to perform Omsbudperson functions for Lane County's managed mental health care organization, LaneCare. These functions include providing technical support and assistance to Oregon Health Plan members and contractors engaged in disputes, receiving complaints and providing information, advice and linkage to appropriate resources. Contractor must have an understanding of mental health services provided under the Oregon Health Plan and applicable Oregon Administrative Rules and Oregon Revised Statutes. Contractor cannot be a member of current LaneCare provider panel due to conflict of interest. The contract period is January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 with two one-year extensions possible depending upon contractor performance and availability of funding. Contractor shall be reimbursed \$75.00 per hour for a total contract amount not to exceed \$10,000 for one contract year.
