

Lane County Environmental Health Announces ServSafe® Class



Lane County Environmental Health is offering a ServSafe® Class and Certification for \$90 including lunch and coffee/soda for breaks, on Tuesday November 10, 2009 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. ServSafe® is a nationally recognized Food Manager Training Course. Your instructor is certified by ServSafe® and is a Lane County Health Inspector. The cost of the class also includes the course book ServSafe® Essentials Fifth Edition and the exam.

The schedule includes time for the exam, a 45 minute lunch break and 2 short coffee breaks. The exam will be administered about 15 minutes after the completion of instruction and takes about 1 hour to complete. The classes will be held in the Carmichael Training Room in the Serbu Juvenile Justice Building, 2727 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Eugene, OR 97401. This is near Autzen Stadium. After you register the book, practice test and directions to the class will be mailed to you. Class size is limited to 30 students. Registration will close when the class is full or on October 23, 2009.

Participants must study the book and take the practice test before the class. Instruction is a review of the ServSafe® Essentials book.
