Lane County Budget Committee Thursday, May 19, 2022 5:30pm – Virtual Meeting

Budget Committee members present: Chair, Herb Vloedman, citizen members: Chris Hazen, Dawn Lesley, Chris Pryor, Bruce Webber, and Lane County.Commisioners: Jay Bozievich, Heather Buch, Pat Farr and Laurie Trieger. Joe Berney reported ahead of meeting that he would be absent.

I. <u>CALL MEETING TO ORDER</u>

Chair Vloedman called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM.

II. <u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>

No public comment presented.

III. <u>COMMITTEE BUSINESS</u>

Commissioner Trieger corrected May 10, 2022 minutes to update Home Servicing to Home Visiting.

Chris Pryor moved to approved minutes as amended for May 3rd, May 5th, May 10th, and May 12th with a 2nd from Commissioner Trieger. Motion passes unanimously.

IV. <u>BUDGET RECAP</u>

Steve Mokrohisky, Lane County Administrator gave a brief recap of the overall budget.

V. <u>BUDGET COMMITTEE DISCUSSION / DELIBERATION</u>

The following Budget Committee member proposals were shared noting at least 4 votes for a proposal to move to be deliberated on.

Commissioner Bozievich gave an overview of his proposal of \$650,000 of Video Lottery funds to Land Management. There were 7 votes by the Budget Committee to move forward to discussion and action.

Commissioner Farr gave an overview of his proposal of Community Organization and Santa Clara Community Organization of \$22,781. There were 6 votes to move forward to discussion and action.

Discussions were held on the moving \$650,000 Video Lottery funds to Land Management for FY 22-23. Motion from Commissioner Bozievich to allocate \$650,000 of Video Lottery to Land Management and to reduce the allocation to Infrastructure Projects with a 2nd from Commissioner Trieger. The motion passes unanimously.

Discussions were held on the proposal for River Road Community Organization and Santa Clara Community Organization. Commissioner Trieger moved to approve funding for River Road Community Organization and Santa Clara Community Organization in the amount of \$25,662 total \$22,781 from Reserves and \$2,881 from Commissioner Farr's account. Bruce Webber 2nd the motion. Motion passes 8 in favor, Commissioner Bozievich voted against.

Ms. Moody shared an overview of the known adjustments.

Motion 1:

Move approval of the FY 2022-2023 Lane County Permanent Tax Rate of \$1.2793 per \$1,000 of Assessed Value.

Motion passes unanimously.

Chris Pryor moved to approve Motion 2 with a 2nd from Bruce Webber.

Motion 2:

Move approval of the FY 2022-2023 Local Option Tax for Jail & Critical Youth Services in the amount of \$0.55 per \$1,000 Assessed Value with \$0.50 for Jail Services and \$0.05 for Youth Services.

Motion passes unanimously.

Chris Pryor moved to approved Motion 3 with a 2nd from Commissioner Trieger.

Motion 3:

Move approval of the FY 2022-2023 Local Option Tax to support 4-H and OSU Extension Programs in Lane County in the amount of \$0.028 per \$1,000 Assessed Value.

Motion passes unanimously.

Chris Pryor moved to approve Motion 4 with a 2nd from Commissioner Trieger.

Motion 4:

Move approval to allow the use of transient room tax dollars for operational purposes consistent with Lane Code 4.005.175 D. E. & F. and ORS 320.350 as follows:

- Lane Events Center \$1,021,135
- Lane County Parks Division \$732,677

Motion passes with 8 in favor, and 1 abstain from Chris Hazen.

Chris Pryor moved to approve Motion 5 with a 2nd from Commissioner Trieger.

Motion 5:

Move approval of entire FY 2022-2023 budget with all adjustments approved by the Budget Committee.

Motion passes unanimously.

Discussions were held in regards to the FY 22-23 Budget Committee process noting:

- Forward looking process not what was done or completed the previous year.
- Presentation on structural imbalances.
- Key performance indicators and metrics.
- Board of County Commissioners share feedback to the Budget Committee citizen members on Lane County achieving metrics.
- Focus on areas changing, revenue sources and structurally balancing the budget.
