WHEREAS, the Justice Reinvestment Grant Program (JRGP) application must be submitted by the local public safety coordinating council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to House Bill 3194 passed by the Legislature in July 2013, Lane County was allocated funds for programs to reduce prison population, reduce recidivism, increase public safety, and increase offender accountability; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission released a Request for Grant Proposals requiring an application to be submitted by each county in order for grant funds to be awarded; and

WHEREAS, Lane County must now revise the application for these funds; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual Chapter 21 sets forth policy regarding award of contracts for services and policy regarding signatory authority of the County Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Plan was developed by the Lane County Public Safety Coordinating Council (PSCC) and the PSCC Budget Committee; and

WHEREAS, the PSCC Budget Committee, as delegated by the PSCC, hereby recommends to the Board of County Commissioners adoption of JRGP budget #8;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1. Accept and approve the 2017-2019 JRGP Budget #8 and application.
- 2. Delegate authority to the PSCC staff to sign and submit the grant application.
- **3.** Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute grant documents, intergovernmental agreements, and contracts related to the 2017-2019 Justice Reinvestment Grant Program for the term of 07/01/2017-06/30/2019:
