WHEREAS, the County has adopted as a strategic priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 20.650 requires that the Board of County Commissioners must approve grant acceptance in excess of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant to be accepted from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration will support one of the BCC/BoH adopted Community Health Improvement Plan goals and/or strategies;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1. Approve the acceptance of a Drug Free Communities grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration in a not-to-exceed amount of \$625,000 for the period September 2014 through September, 2019; and
- 2. Delegate authority to the Department of Health & Human Services to draw down this funding on a quarterly basis, for the duration of the grant.
