Oakridge School District General Obligation Facilities Bond

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall the District issue \$6,200,000 bond for safety upgrades and renovations to its facilities and obtain a \$4,000,000 State grant? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

If this bond is approved, the current tax rate is not expected to increase because the District's current bond will be paid off in July 2018. Oregon Department of Education will provide \$4 million matching funds, for total of \$10.2 million with no expected increase in the current rate. If the bond is not approved, those funds will go to another district. The District would use funds for major renovation of Oakridge Junior/Senior High (OJ/SH) and Oakridge Elementary School (OES). Funds will not be spent on the Westridge Facility.

Primary projects at OES include:

- Fire suppression interior sprinkler system
- Fire alarm upgrades
- Replace two portable classrooms
- Americans with Disabilities upgrades including access ramps, foyer renovations
- Replace gym roof
- HVAC improvements
- Remove asbestos and replace flooring
- Kitchen and cafeteria upgrades

Primary projects at OJ/SH include:

- Fire alarm upgrades
- Replace roof
- Replace HVAC
- Science lab improvements
- Kitchen and cafeteria upgrades

The bond will mature in 31 years or less from date of issuance and may be issued in one or more series.
