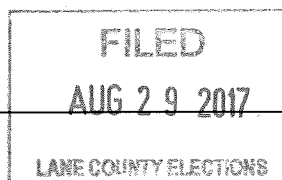

Regulation and Taxation of Recreational Marijuana Businesses in Creswell

Shall the City of Creswell allow certain recreational marijuana businesses to locate within the City subject to specific regulations?		
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.		
<p>The Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) licenses four types of recreational marijuana businesses: retailers, producers, processors and wholesalers. Under existing City of Creswell law, none of these businesses can locate within the City. If adopted, the measure would change City law to allow recreational marijuana retailers, processors and wholesalers in the City, subject to certain limitations. Recreational marijuana producers, both indoor and outdoor, would continue to be prohibited in the City.</p> <p>The measure proposes restrictions on where each type of recreational marijuana business could locate. The measure would also place other restrictions on the operations of these businesses.</p> <p>The measure requires that the Creswell City Council refer a measure to City voters at the November 2018 election to determine whether the City should impose its own local tax of 3% on the sale of recreational marijuana.</p> <p>If adopted, the measure would not regulate medical marijuana facilities licensed by the Oregon Health Authority. The measure also would not regulate recreational marijuana for personal use that does not require a license from the OLCC.</p>
