Five-Year Fire Protection Local Option Levy			
<b>Question</b> 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.			
Shall Rainbow levy \$1.71 per \$1,000 assessed value outside its permanent rate for 5 years, beginning 2019/20? This measure renews current local option taxes <i>OK</i>			
<b>Summary</b> 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
Rainbow contracts with the City of Springfield for fire protection services. This measure renews a measure passed in November 2014 which expires in 2019. WITHOUT THIS LEVY, the District WILL NOT BE ABLE TO CONTINUE FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICE.			
The proposed rate will raise approximately \$715,500 in 2019/20, \$736,000 in 2020/21, \$757,500 in 2021/22, \$779,500 in 2022/23, and \$802,000 in 2023/24, for a total of \$3,790,500 over the five years beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2024. <i>2024</i>			
The rate remains the same as the calculated 2016/17 rate. The levy is based on assessed value, not market value, and will cost \$22.95 per month for an average District home valued at \$161,000. The funds generated from this levy will maintain current level of services and can only be used for fire protection or capital projects which maintain fire protection capabilities.			
The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate. <i>OK</i>
