- Due to the current health situation, there may be delay in responding to phone calls and emails. We will respond as soon as possible and attempt to respond within 24 to 48 business hours.
- In order for someone to access services through Lane County Developmental Disabilities Services they
 must reside in the State of Oregon and be considered a resident of Lane County. If you are applying for
 someone who does not reside in Lane County or the State of Oregon, please contact our office and
 speak to the intake/eligibility team prior to submitting an application regarding your circumstance.
- If someone other than the custodial parent is applying for the child then that person will need to
 provide a copy of the document that shows that have been granted the authority to access services for
 the child.
- For anyone who is 18 or older they will need to apply for themselves. In order for a parent or some
 other support person to apply for someone who is over the age of 18 that person must be the court
 appointed legal guardian and provide that documentation at the time the application is submitted. A
 parent or support person can assist an adult to apply for services, but the adult must sign the
 application and release forms.
- An intake packet can be submitted to our office by: mail, fax, or email. You can also drop a packet off at
 our office. At this time our office is closed to the public, we do have a drop box in which packets and
 other documents can be submitted to our office. Intake packets will be directed to the intake/eligibility
 team for processing.
- Once our office receives an intake packet we will review the documents and contact you if any
 additional information is needed. Our office will then request records from the agencies/providers
 authorized on the release form. Once all available records are obtained and reviewed, we will contact
 you with either a determination, or explain what is needed to complete the determination. The
 process may take up to 90 days.
