

GENERAL LABORER

DEFINITION

To perform unskilled manual tasks.

CLASS CHARACTERISTICS

This is the unskilled level in the Road Maintenance series. Incumbents mainly work during the summer months assisting on special projects and perform year-round recycling services for Waste Management. Since this class is typically used for unskilled manual labor, employees may have only limited or no directly-related work experience.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

Receives general supervision from an assigned supervisor or lead worker.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES - Duties may include, but are not limited to the following:

Assists in diverting traffic around hazards or crews on work projects.

Performs general manual labor.

Operates non-powered tools.

Performs general clean-up.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Basic safety practices and procedures.

Proper use of a variety of non-powered tools.

Ability to:

Perform strenuous physical labor.

Follow simple oral instructions.

Experience and Training

Training:

Any combination of experience and training that would provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying.

Experience:

No experience is required.

Special Requirements:

Possession of a valid Oregon Driver's license if required to drive.
