### **IDENTIFY MAPPED WETLANDS**

Review wetland information from the Department of State Lands (DSL) and the National Wetland Inventory (NWI): <u>https://www.oregon.gov/dsl/WETLAND/Pages/index.aspx</u> (DSL) and <u>https://www.fws.gov/wetlands/</u> (NWI). Please note that these mapped wetlands are not substitutes for the results of on-site field surveys.
