Volunteers must complete and have on record the following to be fully credentialed:

- ✓ Completed Volunteer Registration Form
- ✓ Orientation Session
- ✓ Signed Code of Conduct
- ✓ Complete ICS 100—Introduction to Incident Command System
- ✓ Complete ICS 200—ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents
- ✓ Complete IS 700—Overview of National Incident Management System
- ✓ Standard CPR/First Aid Certification
- ✓ Completed Animal First Aid Course
- ✓ Completion and Successful Testing for Core AID Courses:
 - Introduction to Animal Emergency Management Issues
 - Your Role in an Animal Disaster: Biosafety and Zoonoses
 - Animal Handling Techniques and Responder Safety
 - Personal and Business Disaster Plans and Training Resources
- ✓ Successful Criminal Records Check*
- ✓ ID Badge Photo*

*Call to schedule an appointment for your criminal records check and ID photo after completing all the other elements. There is no charge to volunteers for this service. If you are currently a credentialed CERT team member for the City of Eugene, we may be able to use your documentation of passing their criminal records check so that you will not have to repeat the process. Please plan to bring a valid driver's license or other form of government-issued picture ID to your appointment.
