# Recycling Guide All recycling must be clean.





No cups, diapers, kleenex, paper towels, plates or Tissues.



Paper Newspapers Magazines Cereal & shoe boxes, computer & writing paper, junk mail (no need to remove staples, windows or adhesives), magazines & paper egg cartons.

Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard (has wavy middle layer) & brown paper bags only. Flatten all boxes. No waxed cardboard or packaging material.



Aluminum, steel & tin cans

Aluminum cans, foil & trays. Steel & tin cans. Lids. Labels ok. Rinse. All containers must be 100% empty. Do not flatten or remove lids. Ball up foil & trays into large ball. No dirty material or shiny, flexible plastic pouches.

### recycle glass separately

Glass

Bottles & jars only. Any color. Rinse. Labels & lids ok. No drinking glasses, pyrex, or window glass. No broken glass.

No Liquids, Grease or Cooking Oil,

No Metal,

No Plastic or Styrofoam.
