WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has established the Tourism Special Projects Grant Program that distributes grant money to tourism related projects that have a direct impact on overnight stays in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has appointed members to the Tourism Council to review solicited grant application and provide recommendations to the Board for approval; and

WHEREAS, request for applications were solicited for a 30 day period with a total of 28 applications submitted; and

WHEREAS, the council has provided its recommendations to the Board for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1. That the Tourism Special Projects Grants are approved and awarded for projects shown in Exhibit A, incorporated by this reference; for a total amount of \$51,956.
- **2.** That contracts be prepared for execution by the County and grant recipients on projects required to have contracts.
- 3. That the County Administrator is authorized to sign all necessary contract related to these grant awards.

Evaluation

Grant applications will be reviewed by the Tourism Council appointed by the Lane County Board of Commissioners. The Tourism Council will recommend the top ranking applications to the Board of Commissioners who will then make the final decision on awarding grants.

Amount of Funds Available

A total of up to \$100,000 is available to award to projects through this Invitation to Apply for Funds.
