IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING
LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR THE EVEN-
NUMBERED SESSION OF THE 77TH
LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

WHEREAS, the Lane County has a keen interest in state legislative activities; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Government employs an Intergovernmental Relations Manager for the purpose of advocating on behalf of Lane County government at the Oregon Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Board of County Commissioners wishes to communicate their legislative priorities to the public and other elected officials; and


WHEREAS, the Legislative Committee is the established standing committee which exists to fully inform the Lane County Board of Commissioners in a timely fashion on legislative issues; and

WHEREAS, it has previously been resolved that the Legislative Committee will forward its recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners for final approval by the Board of County Commissioners on an as-necessary basis.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Lane County Board agrees to the priorities forwarded to it by the Legislative Committee as follows:

- 1) Monitor proposed state legislation that may provide public contracting agencies the ability to give preference to local bidders or proposers.
- 2) Provide local delegation with comprehensive list of Lane County policies and principles regarding legalization of marijuana.
- 3) Support for Juvenile Crime Prevention Funding proposed by OJDDA.
- 4) Support for restoration of State Homeless Funds.
- 5) Support for the establishment of the Southwest Oregon Assessment and Taxation Coalition project.
- 6) Support for new governmental accounting practices proposed by Statement 68.
- 7) Support for the Oregon Solutions project regarding RV licensing fee distribution.
- 8) Support for the increase of appropriations to Family Mediation and Conciliation programs.
- 9) Support change to appropriation of County Jail Assessment/DA alcohol impact funding to reflect closure of justice court.
- 10) Support effort to fund sobering emergency services.
- 11) Support expansion of Voluntary Mental Health database with respect to background checks utilized in the purchase of firearms in Oregon.
