ORDER NO: 14-03-18-02

IN THE MATTER OF APPLYING FOR AND APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A DRUG FREE COMMUNITIES GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000 FROM THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

**WHEREAS**, Lane County Public Health and its Prevention team have been working with the Eugene Prevention Coalition over the past year on programs designed to address underage drinking, prescription drug abuse and marijuana use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) has published a grant opportunity for Drug Free Community prevention programs; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the Health & Human Services Public Health Prevention application for SAMHSA grant funding for "Drug Free Communities" prevention programs in the amount of \$125,000 for federal FY15; and
2. Authorize the County Administrator to sign the application and any acceptance documents for the original grant and any subsequent renewals.
