IN THE MATTER OF RATIFYING THE  
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION  
TO APPLY FOR A TOBACCO FREE  
ENVIRONMENT GRANT APPLICATION IN  
THE AMOUNT OF \$226,636 FROM THE  
OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY AND  
APPROVING ACCEPTANCE

**WHEREAS**, Lane County Public Health and its Prevention team desire to broaden the impact of their tobacco prevention programming and messaging; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2013 Legislature has made Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement funding available for tobacco prevention programming via the Oregon Health Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000; and

**WHEREAS**, Health & Human Services was unable to process a request for delegated authority prior to the mandatory grant application submission date of March 31, 2014;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Ratification of the County Administrator's submission of a grant application for Oregon Health Authority grant funding for "Tobacco Free Communities" prevention programs in the amount of \$226,636 for the period May, 2014 through June, 2015; and
2. Authorization is granted to the County Administrator to sign the application and any acceptance documents.
