
WHEREAS, the Board desires to pursue grant funding opportunities to help maintain County parks for broad public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Division and Friends of Buford Park and Mt. Pisgah have identified the need for a realignment of Trail 5 in the Howard Buford Recreation Area; and


WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) is offering a grant opportunity under its Recreation Trails Program for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Division has developed a preliminary budget estimate in the amount of \$185,708, of which \$112,914 would be match, all in volunteer labor hours, and of which \$72,794 would be the OPRD grant request, now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that Lane County Parks is authorized to pursue this grant funding opportunity, and to commit volunteer labor hours, and if successful, the County Administrator is authorized to execute associated intergovernmental agreements.
