ORDER NO: 14-07-22-04

IN THE MATTER OF APPLYING FOR A
THREE-YEAR GRANT IN THE AMOUNT
OF \$500,000 FROM THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

WHEREAS, Lane County Youth Services desires to broaden the impact of its successful Recovery and Progress (RAP) Court, which has been instrumental in reducing youth crime, delinquency and drug/alcohol dependency; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has made available funding for public entities to address issues related to "Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention"; and


WHEREAS, The anticipated start date of the grant is October 1, 2014, but the actual start date is dependent upon the timing of federal funds being allocated for the project.

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Delegation of authority to the County Administrator to submit a grant application for three-year U.S. Department of Justice funding for "Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention" in the amount of \$500,000; and
2. Authorization is granted to the County Administrator to sign the application and any acceptance documents.
