IN THE MATTER OF APPLYING FOR AND ACCEPTING A PHASE II FEDERAL JUSTICE REINVESTMENT INITIATIVE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice offers resources to support Justice Reinvestment Initiatives (JRI's), a comprehensive and supported process to analyze and reform local and state approaches to the deployment of public safety resources; and

WHEREAS In October, 2011, the Department of Justice supported Lane County through a so-called Phase I (non-cash award) JRI process, which primarily was an examination of the existing public safety system and supporting policies; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice provides implementation resources up to \$300,000 to Phase II participants on a competitive basis; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Coordinating Council has adopted a related Implementation Plan and Budget for Phase II in the amount of \$299,986.70; and

WHEREAS, these resources will be used to augment existing resources at Parole and Probation and the Office of the District Attorney, specifically related to electronic monitoring, cognitive behavioral treatment, and a prosecutor focused on property crime felonies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. That the submission of the grant application is approved and that, if awarded, the Lane County Administrator is authorized to execute all associated grant agreements.
