IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING
LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR THE 78TH
LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY-2015 SESSION

WHEREAS, the Lane County has a keen interest in state legislative activities; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Government employs an Intergovernmental Relations Manager for the purpose of advocating on behalf of Lane County government at the Oregon Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Board of County Commissioners wishes to communicate their legislative priorities to the public and other elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Committee is the established standing committee which exists to fully inform the Lane County Board of Commissioners in a timely fashion on legislative issues; and


WHEREAS, it has previously been resolved that the Legislative Committee will forward its recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners for final approval by the Board of County Commissioners on an as-necessary basis; and

WHEREAS, the sheer volume of introduced bills and subsequent amendments produces a drain on existing county resources,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Lane County Board of Commissioners establishes a broad set of Legislative Principles forwarded to it by the Legislative Committee; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the intent of the Legislative Principles Document is to assist in providing a more timely response to members of the Legislature on proposed legislation that may affect Lane County.
