IN THE MATTER OF DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO  
THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT  
GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR TITLE II FUNDING TO  
VARIOUS FEDERAL AGENCIES/DEPARTMENTS  
AND THEIR SUBSIDIARIES

**WHEREAS**, the County has adopted as a strategic Priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has benefited from the receipt of Title II grant funding since 2003 and has applied these funds to the task of training youth in valuable work skills; and

**WHEREAS**, the promotion of job skills improves the lives of youth, providing them with better opportunities for employment and integration into our community as contributing citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the work performed by these juvenile forest crews also benefits the contributing federal agencies and the public at-large, including the victims of the crimes previously committed by the juveniles; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the Delegation of Authority to the County Administrator, for the period September, 2015 through June, 2019, to authorize the submission of grant applications to the Federal Government under Title II in a total amount not-to-exceed \$1,800,000, based on Youth Services' prepared project proposals for juvenile forest work crews.
