ORDER NO: 16-06-21-03

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING MENTAL
HEALTH INVESTMENT EXPANSION
GRANT FUNDING FOR JAIL DIVERSION
AND CRISIS SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT UP
TO \$400,000.

WHEREAS, the County has adopted as a strategic priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and

WHEREAS, in February of 2016, Lane County Department of Health & Human Services submitted grant applications for the expansion of jail diversion and crisis services.; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 20.650(3) delegates authority to the County Administrator to approve and execute all documents in application of a grant in excess of \$100,000 provided the application does not obligate the County to accept the grant if awarded.; and


WHEREAS, Lane County was awarded up to \$400,000 in grant funding.; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 20.650(4) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the acceptance of grants in excess of \$100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1) Approve the acceptance of Mental Health Investment Expansion Grant funding for Jail Diversion and Crisis Services in an amount up to \$400,000.
