NEEDS AT THE 1ST AVENUE SHELTER.


WHEREAS, on July 13, 2016 Parks & Animal Services received a gift from the Harriet Ruby Smith Trust in the amount of \$126,121.00 for Animal Services; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Animal Services Advisory Committee has asked Greenhill Humane Society to submit a list of needs to the committee for consideration and has subsequently made recommendations to the Board to allocate a portion of the funds to address immediate facility needs for the 1st Avenue Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Animal Services Advisory Committee now recommends to the Board to approve the use of \$9,600 of the Harriet Smith Trust towards installing wood fence panels between the dog yards at the 1st Avenue Shelter to mitigate interaction between the dogs and to maximize the quality of care at the facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** that the above project is approved using \$9,600 of the Harriet Ruby Smith Trust.
