IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING
MOTOROLA PROPOSAL "IP
SIMULCAST. G-SERIES UPGRADE, ASR
SITES AND SUBSCRIBER ADD-ON" IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$3,639,984 AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN
THE PURCHASE ORDER AND
CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has previously authorized a Life Cycle contract with Motorola to support and maintain the Lane Radio Interoperability Group (LRIG) radio system; and

WHEREAS, the Life Cycle Contract specifically identifies a required system hardware upgrade, outside of the contract costs, to replace end-of-life-equipment prior to December 2020; and


WHEREAS, the LRIG Consortium has negotiated a contract offer from Motorola that includes the required system upgrades as well as subscriber radio replacements for the LCSO and for the Springfield Police Departments under the HGAC purchasing agreements; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price is deemed reasonable and acceptable by the LRIG Governance Board, Springfield Police Department and the Lane County Sheriff's Office.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. A purchase order be issued to Motorola Corporation in the amount of \$3,639,984 for Radio System Upgrade and Radio Subscriber Units.
2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the purchase order and contract.
