IN THE MATTER OF CREATING A  
TEMPORARY SPEED REDUCTION ON  
SUTTLE ROAD DURING THE OREGON  
COUNTRY FAIR EVENT

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Traffic Engineer, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 810.180(8), has determined that existent conditions on Suttle Road from Mile Post (MP) 2.14 to MP 3.80 constitute a hazard to the public traveling over such sections of roadway at greater than the speed designated below during the annual Oregon Country Fair Event; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon said determination of danger to the public, the Lane County Traffic Engineer has found that when the speed designated in ORS 811.105 is greater than the speed designated below; a temporary speed reduction to lessen the risk to the public is desirable;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS and RESOLVES** as follows:

1. That the designated speed for Suttle Road from MP 2.14 to MP 3.80 will temporarily be reduced to 25 Miles Per Hour.
2. This temporary event reduced speed zone is only in effect Thursday through Monday of the Oregon Country Fair event each year.
3. This reduced speed zone will be documented annually in a memo prepared by the Lane County Traffic Engineer and shared with the Oregon Department of Transportation.


