

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 19-06-18-07

IN THE MATTER OF MAKING SOLE SOURCE DETERMINATIONS FOR SELECTION OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL OF LANE COUNTY TO PROVIDE YEAR-ROUND DUSK-TO-DAWN SAFE SLEEPING AND EMERGENCY WINTER WARMING SERVICES, AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH THE SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER.

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual Chapter 20 sets forth policy regarding the competitive award of contracts and policy regarding signatory authority of the County Administrator; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane County conducted a Request for Qualified Providers for each of these services and St. Vincent de Paul was the only respondent to each of the requests; and

**WHEREAS, Lane County** posted notice of its intent to contract with the St. Vincent de Paul of Lane County for both Year-Round Dusk-to-Dawn Safe Sleeping and Emergency Winter Warming Services and no comments or protests to the proposed award of funds were received; and

**WHEREAS**, the sole source amount is beyond the County Administrator's delegated authority;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. St. Vincent de Paul of Lane County is determined to be a Sole Source provider of Year-Round Dusk-to-Dawn Safe Sleeping for \$3,780,000 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022; and
2. St. Vincent de Paul of Lane County is determined to be a Sole Source provider of Emergency Winter Warming Services for \$291,807 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022; and
3. Authority is delegated to the County Administrator to sign expense contracts with St. Vincent de Paul of Lane County for Year-Round Dusk-to-Dawn Safe Sleeping for \$3,780,000 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022 and Emergency Winter Warming Services for \$291,807 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022.
