

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 20-04-07-04

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING ROAD
FUND EXPENDITURES FOR CODE EN-
FORCEMENT EFFORTS ON LOCAL AC-
CESS ROADS (LAR)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, through Order 06-1-18-8, authorized the Department of Public Works to investigate complaints and inquiries related to conditions on Local Access Roads (LARs) and to take appropriate action as necessary; and

WHEREAS, ORS 368.031 provides that counties may expend county funds on Local Access Roads if the work is an emergency; or if the county road official recommends the expenditures, the public use of the road justifies the expenditure, and the county governing body enacts an order or resolution authorizing the work and designating the work to be either single project or a continuing program; and

WHEREAS, the county road official has approved of Road Fund expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works staff has identified evidence justifying Road Fund expenditure for the public's best interest and explicitly requests authority to investigate and provide enforcement for reported abandoned vehicles, as well as illegal roadside activities; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it appropriate to spend Road Fund money for the express purpose of code enforcement on LARs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

Lane County Public Works is authorized to use Road Fund money to investigate and provide enforcement for reported abandoned vehicles and illegal roadside activities on Local Access Roads (LARs).
