PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE FOR THOSE
ELEVATORS, AND DELEGATING
AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE
CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the elevators at the Lane County Adult Corrections Facility, 101 W 5th Ave, Eugene, OR, are original to the 1979 construction of that facility and are beyond their expected useful life; and

WHEREAS, these elevators are critical for providing necessary building access to inmates, security and medical personnel, meal deliveries, and laundry services; and

WHEREAS, the project for modernizing these elevators is included in the Capital Improvement Plan and funding has been identified; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Operations has reviewed and approved this project and its funding source;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The LCAC Elevator Modernization Project is approved for funding and construction.
2. The County Administrator is granted authority to execute all contracts relative to this project.
