In the Matter of Approving Pay Grade
Increases for the Juvenile Justice Specialist
and Sr. Justice Court Clerk Classifications
Within the Lane County American Federation
of State County and Municipal Employees
Local 2831 – General Unit Based on the
Article 19 Classification Review for 2019

WHEREAS, Lane County and the Lane County American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Local 2831 – General Unit (AFSCME) agreed under Article 19 of the 2017-2020 contract to conduct a classification review of selected classifications within the unit each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, a classification review was conducted for 2019-2020 of the selected classifications by Lane County staff; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has considered the staff recommendations in conjunction with County-wide guiding principles on employee compensation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. That the recommended increase for the Juvenile Justice Specialist classification from Grade 22 to Grade 23 for FY20-21 is approved;
2. That the recommended increase for the Juvenile Justice Specialist-Bilingual classification from Grade 24 to Grade 25 for FY 20-21 is approved;
3. That the recommended increase for the Sr. Justice Court Clerk classification from Grade 24 to Grade 25 for FY 20-21 is approved;
4. That the County Administrator and County staff are authorized to implement the Board ordered adjustments on behalf of the County to be effective the first full pay period following July 1, 2020.
