(COSSAP) GRANT AWARD THROUGH

ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$900,000 FOR THE LANE COUNTY JAIL
SUBSTANCE USE INTERVENTION AND
TRANSITION PROGRAM, DELEGATING
AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE
AWARD DOCUMENTS AND
ASSOCIATED SUB-CONTRACTS AND
INCREASING FY 20-21
APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SPECIAL
REVENUE FUND WITHIN THE
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000

WHEREAS, the Lane County Department of Public Safety (also known as the Sheriff's Office), has been awarded a three year Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$900,000 for use in the Lane County Jail;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the awarded grant is for the Lane County Jail Substance Use Intervention and Transition Program in partnership with Health & Human Services and the jail's medical provider WellPath to provide substance abuse counseling, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) and recovery support to adults while in custody at the Lane County Jail with a warm hand-off to community partners upon release;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, per ORS 294.338(2), has the authority to appropriate unforeseen specific purpose grant revenue through a Resolution; and

WHEREAS the need, the purpose, and the amount of the grant are herein described;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **RESOLVES and ORDERS** as follows:

1. Lane County, through the Department of Public Safety (Sheriff's Office), is approved to accept the Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant and Substance Abuse Site-Based Program (COOSAP) grant from the Bureau of Justice in the amount of \$900,000 over three years.
2. The County Administrator is delegated the authority to sign and execute the resulting grant award with the Bureau of Justice Assistance and any associated sub-contracts.
3. Appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, are increased as follows:
