

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 21-03-02-04

IN THE MATTER OF PROHIBITING  
THROUGH TRUCK MOVEMENTS ON  
JASPER ROAD FROM SOUTH 42<sup>ND</sup>  
STREET (MILE POST 0.00) TO BOB  
STRAUB PARKWAY (MILE POST 2.69) IN  
SPRINGFIELD.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to ORS 810.030, the County may impose restrictions and prohibit the operation of any or all vehicles or any class or any kind of vehicle to protect any highway or section of highway from being unduly damaged and to protect the interest and safety of the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2004 and 2007 Lane County constructed the Jasper Road Extension, now known as Bob Straub Parkway, for the purpose of shifting traffic away from the residential roads in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners accepted the right-of-way and dedication as a Public road the newly constructed Bob Straub Parkway, formerly known as Jasper Road Extension, and establish it as a County road, County Road No. 2555 (Board Order 07-7-11-11); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners accepted the jurisdictional transfer from the Oregon Department of Transportation the section of the Springfield-Creswell Highway, State Highway No. 222, from South 42<sup>nd</sup> Street to Jasper-Lowell Road, the section of roadway commonly known as Jasper Road, and established as County Road No. 2273 (Board Order 07-10-3-7; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Springfield has restricted truck movements on South 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, the City section of Jasper Road from South 42<sup>nd</sup> Street to South 32<sup>nd</sup> Street, and South 32<sup>nd</sup> Street.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. That a "No Thru Trucks" restriction be placed on Jasper Road (County Road No. 2273).
