ORDER 21-03-30-10

In the Matter of Adopting Recommendations  
of the Lane County Legislative Committee  
Regarding Congressional Directed  
Spending.

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Legislative Committee's function is to oversee all aspects of legislative and administrative policy making by other deliberative bodies which may affect Lane County's legislative program per Lane Manual 3.670; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Legislative Committee met on March 12, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the topics discussed at the meeting was the potential return of Congressionally Directed Spending; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane County has for many years participated in a regional coalition of agencies that identifies regional priorities to be communicated to the Lane County Congressional delegation; and

**WHEREAS**, the House has since released guidance on how to identify potential community projects for both the Surface Transportation Bill Re-Authorization effort and the annual budget process; and

**WHEREAS**, Department Directors have elevated a number of projects for consideration.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1.) The Lane County priorities for consideration and support include:
  - a. Territorial Highway, Complete Phases 2-4, Public Works
  - b. Marcola Rd bridge, seismic improvements, Public Works
  - c. Dillard Rd interchange study, Public Works
  - d. Climate Mitigation, Short Mountain Landfill, Public Works
  - e. Transportation and Safety Prevention Programming, Public Works
  - f. Body Cameras, LCSO
  - g. Emergency Communications Resiliency, LCSO
  - h. Frequent User System Engagement, Community Navigators, HHS
  - i. South Lane Clinic, FQHC, HHS
  - j. Permanent Supported Housing, Wrap Around Services, HHS
  - k. Building Equity and Resilience in Lane County Communities, HHS
