I. MOTION

In the Matter of Accepting the 2011-2012 Managed Mental Health Agreement from the State of Oregon and Awarding Subcontracts as Listed in Appendix A.

II. DISCUSSION

A. Background / Analysis

LaneCare, the Managed Mental Health Program for Oregon Health Plan (OHP) members, is a federally funded program administered through the Oregon Health Authority to provide managed mental health care services to OHP members. LaneCare has been managing the mental health services for OHP members in Lane County for the past fourteen years. The annual budget is approximately 32 million dollars serving the approximately 51,000 Oregon Health Plan members in Lane County.

The Mental Health Organization Agreement between Lane County and the Oregon Health Authority specifies that the "Contractor shall maintain and monitor a Provider Panel that is supported with written agreements, and that has sufficient capacity and expertise to provide adequate, timely and medically appropriate access to covered services to Oregon Health Plan members across the age span from child to older adult." A Request for Qualified Providers for mental health services was released in September of 2009 covering the period January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2012. Agencies which responded to the Request for Qualified Providers and who were qualified to be on the Provider Panel were issued contracts.

Letters of Interest for Psychiatrists and Nurse Practitioners to serve on the Provider Panel were also released in September 2009 covering the period January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2012. All letters of interest received were invited to serve on the Provider Panel.

The Managed Mental Health contract will be for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012 due to the reorganization of the Medicaid physical and mental health plans into Coordinated Care Organizations with a projected implementation date of October 1, 2012.

The subcontracts listed in Appendix A represent the third year of the three-year competitive selection.

B. Recommendation

To approve the motion stated above and accept the 2011-2012 Managed Mental Health agreement and delegate contract signature authority to the County Administrator to execute the 2011-2012 Managed Mental Health agreement and ensuing contracts and amendments for the managed mental health provider panel and managed mental health services.

WHEREAS, Medicaid physical and mental health plans will reorganize into Coordinated Care Organizations with a projected implementation date of October 1, 2012, and;

WHEREAS, The Oregon Health Authority will release the Managed Mental Health Contract for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012, and;

WHEREAS, the 2011-2012 Managed Mental Health contract will provide mental health services to the 50,000 Oregon Health Plan members residing in Lane County and;

WHEREAS, delegation of signature authority to the County Administrator to sign contracts and amendments for managed mental health services is required by Lane Manual 21.145.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners approve accepting the 2011-2012 Managed Mental Health agreement in the amount of 32 million dollars for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012 and delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the agreement and

IT IS ALSO HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign all ensuing contracts and amendments for the Managed Mental Health Provider Panel and Managed Mental Health services as listed in Appendix A.
