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**I. PROPOSED MOTION**

MOVE APPROVAL OF THE ORDER AND RESOLUTION IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING JUDITH HAMPTON AND ROB JEROME TO THE LANE COUNTY COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES ADVISORY BOARD.

**II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM**

The Lane County Board of Commissioners has the appointing authority for membership on advisory boards and commissions pursuant to the Lane Manual and to HB 2004, and therefore approves recommendations for appointment to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families.

**III. DISCUSSION**

**A. Background/Analysis**

In 1993, the State Legislature adopted HB 2004 and directed the creation of local Commissions on Children and Families in all 36 counties throughout the state, charging the commissions with responsibility for system-wide strategic planning and implementation of a wellness model for children and families.

In January 1994, the Lane County Board of Commissioners appointed 15 members to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families (LCCCF). In accordance with HB 2004, terms were to be four years in length and staggered. In March 1997 and November 2001, LCCCF adopted by-laws (approved by the BCC) that created, respectively, two youth positions and one additional youth position. With the addition of these three positions the commission currently has 18 members. The by-laws define membership as two (2) County Commissioners, one from a rural and one from a metro district; three (3) youth representatives (between the ages of 15 and 20 at the time of appointment); two (2) rural representatives; and eleven (11) at large members.

Pursuant to HB 2004, a majority of members, plus the chair of local commissions, must be laypersons. LCCCF must have a minimum of nine (9) laypersons and up to eight (8) professional members.

On October 3, 2003, two (2) positions on the LCCCF were publicly posted. Seven (7) applications were received prior to the November 12, 2003 deadline. The Membership Committee conducted interviews and made their recommendation for appointment to the full Commission.

On December 2, 2003, the LCCCF approved 11:0 the Membership Committee's

recommendation to appoint **Judith Hampton and Rob Jerome**. Both appointees will fill vacant Lay seats on the Commission.

The recommended candidates are listed below, followed by the expired or resigned position they will be filling, and the new expiration date of their term.

**B. Alternatives/Options**

1. Adopt the Order and Resolution to appoint two (2) new members to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families.
2. Adopt the Order and Resolution, but alter the list of members at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners.
3. Reject the Order and Resolution, do not appoint the member to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families, and direct staff and the LCCCF on how to proceed.

**C. Recommendation**

Option 1: Adopt the Order and Resolution and to appoint two (2) new members to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families.

**III. IMPLEMENTATION/TIMING**

Upon approval of the Order and Resolution, new members will be informed of their appointment. A brief welcome/orientation meeting will be held in January 2004, and the new members will attend their first Lane County Commission on Children and Families meeting on January 21, 2004. An intensive orientation and training for new members will be scheduled at that meeting and will be held shortly thereafter.

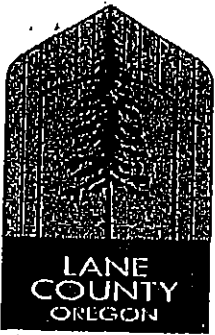

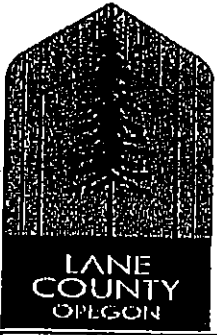

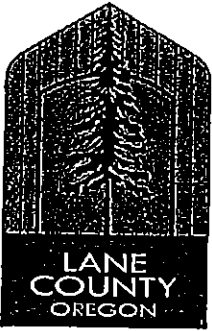

1. After graduating from the University of Oregon School of Law in 1995, I served as a judicial clerk in the Lane County Circuit Court and then practiced law in Eugene. I am currently taking a break from the practice of law and fulfilling my dream of being a stay-at-home dad for our two year old daughter, Olivia. I believe both my legal training and my experience as a stay-at-home dad in Lane County would serve me well if I were selected to serve on the Commission on Children and Families.
2. The opportunities available to children and parents in Lane County are truly amazing. Like many parents, I am concerned about maintaining the programs, parks and services available to our children given our current funding crisis. In addition to maintaining the recreational and educational opportunities available to the children of Lane County, I would also like to help develop new programs and services after our current financial situation improves. As a stay-at-home dad, I would hope to contribute a somewhat non-traditional viewpoint on child rearing and to help develop programs and services to help all couples and single parents in Lane County with the monumental privilege and challenge of raising a healthy and happy child.
3. Given the current funding situation, I would like to make sure that the opportunities currently available to Lane County's children remain open to all of Lane County's children. For example, I was disheartened to learn that Lane County was considering imposing a parking fee for users of Mt. Pisgah. I testified before the Board of County Commissioners to relay my concern that many children would no longer be able to use the area as some parents would not be able to afford to pay a parking fee each time they wanted to take their children on a short hike. I was impressed with the thought and consideration which the Commissioners gave to this issue and believe that they developed a parking fee pass system which will allow Lane County's children to continue to enjoy Mt. Pisgah's recreational and educational benefits. I understand that tough choices must be made during difficult fiscal times and that imposing a fee based system may be the best option when the alternative is to eliminate a program or recreational opportunity. However, I believe children from all socioeconomic groups in Lane County must continue to be considered when difficult funding decisions are made.

I was and raised in Lane County. I love my community and I have seen it grow and change into a place that I want to raise my children. I feel that being a part of the Commission on Children and Families is a way for me to give back to the community that had a big hand in my own upbringing.

I feel that as a young member of this committee I will bring a unique voice to a group that provides essential help to the core of any community, its families. As a college student I have a special interest in providing better services to students of all ages as well as young families. I feel that families with young parents are often left without the needed help in raising their children.

I would like to bring a different perspective to this committee. I have an interest in political happenings in our county, state and country, and I believe that this committee will be a great way for me to extend my knowledge, interest and unique viewpoint to bettering the community.

As a member of this committee I would like to see a greater network of community resources to aid families in bringing up our youth. Being raised in a lower-socioeconomic household, without a father, I saw first hand exactly where a lot of the community stood in helping broken families. I would like to see the community come together as a whole to aid in raising children who come from families where many resources aren't readily available.

Too many youth fall through the cracks simply because they are raised in a single-parent home with little to no supervision. The programs available for parents to utilize don't fit all youth. So we have a large group of so-called latchkey kids who are left to watch themselves all afternoon and through the summer. We as a community need to form better relationships between schools, parents and recreational districts to better accommodate the latchkey child.

Along with these programs for our pre-teens and teens, I would like to see better medical and dental services for families who do not have the ability to purchase insurance. The Oregon Health Plan has major holes in its services, leaving out most college students and small families. Several group plans also eliminate children once they graduate high school, leaving hundreds of young adults in Lane county with no means for health insurance. This is another of my major concerns.

4.

As an employee of both Willamalane Park and Recreation District and Easter Seals Pool, I have had an invested interest in the well being of our community for most of my vocation. I

have a great regard for the time and energy that goes into raising and teaching children. I have seen the problems facing the youth of our community for many years. I also have seen problems facing the family unit.
