4 FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$68,296.

1. Proposed Motion:

MOVE TO ACCEPT BID LCP 2003-06 FOR A MATERIALS & SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE LANE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS CONSOLE FURNITURE FOR THE BASE BID AMOUNT OF \$64,264, PLUS OPTIONS 2-4 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4032, FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$68,296.

2. Issue/Problem:

As a result of changes in the AIRS law enforcement system and the upgrade of the associated technology, the Sheriff's Office requested a remodel of the Dispatch Center to more efficiently operate. An agenda item approving the remodel of the center has already been approved. This contract will provide for the communications console furniture that will be placed in the center.

3. Discussion:

3.1 Background

A bid for the materials and services contract for the Sheriff's Office Communications Console Furniture was prepared and advertised in the Register-Guard on September 8, 2003, and Daily Journal of Commerce on September 4, 2003 and The Skanner on September 10, 2003. In response to the Invitation for Bid, two bids were received.

Analysis

All bids were evaluated by Management Services, and by the Sheriff's Office for conformance to bid specifications and requirements. The bid submitted by Watson Furniture Group, was determined to best meet the bid specifications and had the lowest price.

3.2 Alternatives/Options

- a. Accept the bid from Watson Furniture Group and award contract;
 or
- b. Reject bids.

3.3 Recommendation

It is recommended that award of bid LCP 2003-06 be made to the low responsive bidder, Watson Furniture Group based on conformance to bid specifications and the lowest price; a contract be signed by the vendor; and the County Administrator be authorized to execute the contract.

4. Implementation/Follow-Up

Following approval of the bid award, a contract will be signed by the vendor and delivered to the County Administrator for execution.
