Dear Sir/Ma'am:

This letter is in response to your request for applications to the Service Stabilization Task Force. Hopefully it will provide information requested in the first two questions on the application form.

I am interested in becoming a member of this task force because I feel I could provide some input based on the views of an ordinary taxpayer. In doing so I feel that I would get some satisfaction out of participating in the organization of my local government. I have never had any aspirations of getting involved in politics, but the budgetary process of the county seems like a worthwhile cause to me. I have no experience in "large and financially complex organizations", but I am 59 years old and have lived my entire life and raised a family on a budget. I have consistently made purchasing decisions to provide healthy living conditions while maintaining a stable fiscal environment for my family. From the day I started earning a steady wage (\$1,000 per year as a 17 year old Navy recruit) to the current culmination (almost) of my career I have maintained a minimum amount of debt and an excellent credit rating through a series of financial variances brought about by job changes and national economic conditions.

I am currently employed as an electronics technician and have worked in that capacity throughout most of my career. During my 40's I enrolled in night classes at a local community college and earned an associates degree in Accounting because I briefly considered a career change into that field. I graduated and went on to earn my junior year's worth of credits in that field before deciding to abandon that particular endeavor. I made that decision based on economic concerns. I felt the cost of tuition simply could not justify the personal satisfaction I was getting out of my classes. I have owned three homes, rented numerous apartments, and fully purchased eight different automobiles at various times in my life. I am by no means wealthy, but I am financially stable and have been so for most of my career. Even during the periods when things got a bit dicey I still managed to adjust my spending to maintain an excellent credit rating.

I am not sure what sort of make-up you are planning for this task force, but I strongly feel that if you do not provide for some input from ordinary citizens then you will be losing a considerable amount of value from your efforts. We are the ones who ultimately approve (or disapprove) your efforts by the ballot. You need only recall the results of past referendums to realize that this is essential.

Question 1 – experience

I am currently a commissioner on the Lane County Commission on Children and Families (3 years) and I was past chair of the Lane County Human Rights Advisory Committee. I have also testified to the BCC and the Budget Committee about budget allocations for both the Department of Children and Families and the Human Resources Department. In addition I am actively involved in state politics, serving as local staff for Representative Bob Ackerman (HD 13) and the Legislative Advisory Chair for the Oregon Education Association. I have also served on the CCF Legislative Task Force. Therefore, I know how to work in committee, understand parliamentary procedure, and most importantly, the value of discussion and compromise. I am also knowledgeable about many of the private sector that Lane County partners up with. Additionally, I know what the impacts reduced services have on the people of Lane County, especially disadvantaged populations.

Question 4 — Awareness of Budget and general purpose government
Having testified in front of the BCC and Budget Committee I have gained some
knowledge about the budget, especially as it relates to DHS, DCF, or Human Resources. I
am less familiar with budget lines about Public Works or the Sheriff.
As for "General Purpose Government", which the Board has defined as the current level
of service delivery, Lane County is not intended to be a permanent safety net for all
citizens. General Purpose means that areas which provide a basic framework (roads, open
space, basic health services(prevention), public safety, family stability) are the highest
priority. If there is more money available, the County can provide more intricate services
like counseling, wellness, job training, and child care. While I firmly believe it is the
responsibility of ALL levels of government to provide for a safe, secure, meaningful
existence for its constituents, there are also fiscal limitations and other partners. At its
heart, we should first do no harm, secondly we should look at prevention as a key
component, and finally, we should be culturally competent, which includes awareness of
rural needs as well.

- 1. Lane County has many unique qualities. One of those is the fact that over 50% of Lane County is Federal forestland. In addition, there are hundreds of thousands of acres of private or industrial forestland. That adds up to a huge interest in forestland and forestland issues by Lane County. As a graduate of the College of Forestry at Oregon State University and an employee in the private timber industry, I hope to utilize my knowledge of forestland issues in serving on this task force.
- 2. I believe people have an obligation to become involved in their communities, but for the last few years I have not had the desire to do that. My focus, instead, has been on my wife's health, our own financial situation, and the birth of our daughter. As our family now moves toward a bright future, I am feeling excited about the idea of being involved once again. In addition, I feel this is a good opportunity to learn more about local government. As a member of this task force I would hope to fulfill my duties by listening and learning first, respecting the process and the ideas of other teammates, and hopefully by offering some unique ideas or creative solutions to long terms challenges.
- 3. One of my current roles is managing a road construction/ road maintenance crew. As part of this role I help to prepare an annual budget of approximately 4.5 million dollars. I understand road maintenance and road construction issues, especially as they pertain to rural roads, which Lane County controls many of. More importantly I understand the importance of good budgets, as they can prevent or accommodate surprises down the road.
- 4. Lane County's General Fund is funded primarily from user fees and service charges, federal monies (from historical timber revenues), and property taxes. The federal monies are set to expire in 2007 and seeking an extension to this funding is a high priority for Lane County. On the flip side, costs are rising rapidly due to health care, PERS, fuel and utilities. The costs facing Lane County are not unlike those facing its citizens, but with caps set on certain

revenues (federal money and property tax) it may prove more challenging to balance the budget. The discretionary portion of the General Fund (approximately 50 million dollars) is what the Service Stabilization Task Force will help scrutinize. Hopefully, the task force will also have an opportunity to explore creative solutions to increasing revenue for Lane County.

In my mind, a "general purpose" government is one that provides its citizens with a wide range of publicly funded services, and offers them a voice when deciding which services are of the highest priority.

- 5. There are no specific issues I would like to see addressed. I only hope to see that the county's services are affordable and accessible to as many of Lane County's citizens as possible.
- 6. I am a graduate of the 2000 Eugene/ Springfield Chamber of Commerce Leadership Class. This course educates its students in the workings of local government, non-profits, and private business. It also promotes community involvement.

Also in 2000 I served as a volunteer tutor/ mentor at the Lane County Juvenile Justice Center (Serbu). I tutored many young inmates in reading, writing, and arithmetic.

From 1998 to 2000 I coached soccer in the Sheldon area for Kidsports. The first team I coached, then a group of sixth graders, went on to win the OSAA class 4A state soccer championship in 2003 as juniors at Sheldon High School.

I have been a member of Veteran's of Foreign Wars since 1993 for combat service in Somalia with the United States Army.

Service levels are undergoing sharp reduction due to deep state and local budget reductions. The County is projecting a budget deficit for the next four years. For fiscal year 2003-04, state reductions combined with steep Public Employees Retirement System and healthcare benefits costs created a serious shortfall: \$20 million for the total budget and \$5.75 million in the general fund.

General Purpose Government to me means 1) combine resources for the general welfare i.e. public safety, zoning, tax collection, road building, etc. 2) combine resources for those in need: mental health, children and families, human services, helping the low income and disenfranchised is to everyone's benefit.

As a percentage of the Discretionary General Fund, Public Safety (Youth Services, DA, Justice Courts and Sheriff's Office) accounts for 65 percent of the budget, Public Services (Assessment and Taxation, Children and Families, Health and Human Services, Public Works) accounts for 16 percent, and Support Services (County Administration, County Counsel, Management Services and General Expenses) accounts for 19 percent.

The General Fund (of which the Discretionary General Fund is a portion)

Special Revenue Funds include dedicated funds such as the road fund and school fund.

In order to answer the second half of question #4, I have taken the time to review the Strategic Plan (2001-2005) for Lane County and I would like to comment on a part of it that I think pertains to the mandate of the Service Stabilization Task Force for which I am applying. P#iii states "that the county's highest funding priority will be those services that are effective in addressing the immediate and critical life and health safety needs of our citizens." These are what we think of as general purpose government items such as police services for rural areas, corrections and public health, all of which fit the mission and vision statement on P#7 of the Strategic Plan and which constitute the major items in the county's budget.

One of these items, the corrections item would seem to me to be a high priority item and, therefore, needs to be addressed by the Service Stabilization Task Force. One of the major goals of corrections is to incarcerate people whose behavior indicates that they are a threat to the safety needs of the citizens of Lane County. However, as the Strategic Plan states on P#iii "... Lane County has placed its highest priority on PREVENTION SERVICES which have the best chance of reducing the need for additional services in the long run." A second, major goal of corrections, therefore, must be the rehabilitation of inmates in order to reduce the rate of recidivism., allowing more of the county's scarce resources to be devoted to meeting the needs of the citizens of Lane County.

At the present time, the demand for correction space exceeds the supply. I would like to have the Service Stabilization Task Force concentrate on reducing the DEMAND for spaces since finances are not available to increase the supply and to do so would take scarce revenues away from public health, police services and services to families and children.

On P#iii are identified five strategies for revenue development, one of which is identifying and recovering user fees and charges. I would like the Task Force to identify all of these user fees and charges and to discuss which of these fees and charges have what economists refer to as "inelastic demand". A fee or charge which has such a demand is one where the fee or charge could be increased without lessening the demand by a larger % than the % increase in the fee or charges. For the sake of discussion, let us assume that fees charges to developers could be increased by 10% without a 10% reduction in demand for building permits. In this case, the County could increase its fees and charges for such a county service. I would assume that the other four strategies outlined would also be explored by the Task Force.

I hope this gives you an insight into what I could bring to this Task Force and what what areas I would like the Task Force to explore.
