**AGENDA ITEM, TITLE OR SUBJECT:** In the matter of award of bid LCP 2003-08 for requirements purchase of pharmacy services for Lane County Adult Corrections.

#### II. MOTION

MOVE THAT THE LOW RESPONSIVE BIDDER, DIAMOND PHARMACY SERVICE, BE AWARDED A CONTRACT; THAT A THREE-YEAR REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH BID SPECIFICATIONS; AND THAT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE CONTRACT.

#### II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

The current pharmacy contract for Lane County Adult Corrections has expired, and extended to March 31, 2004 pending the outcome of the bid process for a new contract. The bidding process is complete, and a successful bidder identified. The bid needs to be formally accepted and a contract executed.

#### III. DISCUSSION

#### A. Background

The County has had a three year pharmacy contract with Contract Pharmacy Services to provide pharmaceutical products and services to Lane County Adult Corrections. The contract expired December 13, 2003 and subsequently extended to March 31, 2004. An invitation to submit bids for a new contract was issued with a closing date of November 25, 2003. Six bids were received and evaluated by Lane County Adult Corrections employees Richard Sherman, Mark Graham and Diane Lay.

The lowest bidder, Diamond Pharmacy Services, was also identified as the preferable provider based on overall qualifications and quality of proposed

services.

# B. Analysis

Based on the quality of services to be provided, and cost for products and services, Diamond Pharmacy Services is the recommended provider for the next three year contract period.

### C. Alternatives/Options

None

#### D. Recommendation

It is recommended that award of bid LCP 2003-08 be made to the lowest responsive bidder, Diamond Pharmacy Services, based on conformance to bid specifications; that a contract be signed by the vendor; and that the County Administrator be authorized to execute the contract.

# E. Timing

This process should begin immediately to complete contract execution by March 31, 2004.

#### IV. IMPLEMENTATION/FOLLOW-UP

Following approval of the bid award, a contract will be signed by the vendor and delivered to the County Administrator for execution.
