#### II. ISSUE

Board approval is required to award a contract for the Laurelwood Re-Construction: Phase Six, located in Florence, Oregon .

#### III. DISCUSSION

#### A. Background:

The Agency is in the process of doing comprehensive modernization of the 30 units of Public Housing in Florence, Oregon, known as Laurelwood Homes. This is the sixth phase of this modernization work, and this phase is to demolish and totally rebuild one duplex (two units). The exterior work includes total building demolition and removal, construction of new buildings with additional concrete footings, slabs and ramps.

#### B. Analysis

A formal bid process with a bid package was issued by the Agency for the required work. Plans were placed in various plan centers, and the project was advertised in local papers. Two responsive bids were obtained, and the lowest bidder is both responsive and responsible and they have reviewed their bid and confirmed their costs.

## C. Alternatives/Options

In that the public bidding process was employed, the lowest bid of \$195,750 has no irregularities and is responsive and responsible, the prices are considered competitive, and there are sufficient budget funds to cover the project, we recommend award of the contract to Mallard Construction and Development, Inc.

## E. Timing

Upon bid award, the contractor shall have ten days to provide the Agency with a signed contract. It is anticipated that all other necessary documents could be processed by November 22, 2004 and work would commence shortly thereafter.
