#### I. PROPOSED MOTION

MOVE TO APPROVE THE AMENDMENT TO CHANGE THE LIMITED DURATION 1.0 FTE DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY 1 (DDA1) IN THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO A REGULAR UNLIMITED DURATION POSITION.

#### II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

Should Lane County change the 1.0 FTE limited duration Deputy District Attorney 1 (DDA1) position in the District Attorney's Office to a regular unlimited duration position?

#### III. DISCUSSION

### A. Background

Over the past few years the District Attorney's Office has had to cut five attorney positions due to budget reductions. This has left the office extremely understaffed. Board Order No. 04-7-21-8 used the lapse from a Senior Prosecutor's position (created when Alex Gardner was appointed as District Attorney) to fund the 1.0 FTE Deputy District Attorney 1 (DDA1) limited duration position through June 30, 2004.

The District Attorney's Office has recently experienced restructuring which has resulted in under-filling several more senior attorney positions. The under filled positions will create approximately \$105,000 in available lapse for FY05-06 to fund the 1.0 FTE Deputy District Attorney 1 (DDA1) position at a regular unlimited duration status at a cost of approximately \$75,000 to \$85,000.

District Attorney Alex Gardner has identified the funds with which to pay for this amendment. The change in position status will assist the office in the prosecution of crimes, by bringing the office from it's present status of nine lawyers short to only eight lawyers short during the next year.

### B. Analysis

There is no cost to Lane County to adopt the proposal, as it uses lapse from already authorized positions.

## C. Alternatives/Options

- 1. Adopt the Order.
- 2. Reject the Order.

## D. Recommendation

The District Attorney recommends alternative one.

## E. Timing and Implementation

There is no specific information regarding timing and implementation.
