COMMITTEE CHARGE:

The Board of Property Tax Appeals is responsible for hearing taxpayer appeals for the reduction of the assessed value or specially assessed value of property as of January 1; the real market value of property, but only if the maximum assessed value of the property that is the subject of the petition is determined under ORS 308.149 to 308.166; and correction to value made under ORS 311.208. The board shall also consider applications to excuse or reduce liability for the penalty imposed under ORS 308.295. The Board of Property Tax Appeals shall consist of those persons selected by the County Clerk from the pool of board members appointed under ORS 309.067. The board shall consist of one member of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1)(a) and two members of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1)(b). The term of each member begins on the date of appointment, and shall end on June 30 following appointment or when the member resigns or is replaced. Any non-office holding Lane County resident appointed to the pool may serve on any board as needed for the efficient conduct of business. All persons appointed as members of a pool must complete training approved by the Department of Revenue for the term of appointment. Members shall be compensated for their expenses in the manner provided in ORS 309.022 (2). The per diem rate is \$10.00 per hour. Each board shall consist of one chair and two other members selected from the appointed pools.

C. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

Pursuant to ORS 309.067 (5) on or before October 15 of each year the Lane County Board of Commissioners shall appoint two pools of board members who may be selected by the County Clerk to sit on the Board of Property Tax Appeals. The County Clerk may select additional boards, if necessary, for the efficient conduct of business. Each board shall consist of one non-office holding resident member of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (a) representing the Board of Commissioners, and two members of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (b), representing non-office holding residents of Lane County who are not employees of the county or of any taxing district within the county.
