AGENDA ITEM TITLE: Order/ In the Matter of Appointing a Five Member Citizen Committee to Evaluate and Recommend Awards for the Lane County Tourism Special Projects Grants for the Year 2005.

I. MOTION

MOVE TO APPOINT A FIVE-MEMBER CITIZEN COMMITTEE TO EVALUATE AND RECOMMEND AWARDS FOR THE LANE COUNTY TOURISM SPECIAL PROJECT GRANTS FOR THE YEAR 2005.

II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

Should Lane County appoint a 5-member citizen committee to evaluate and make recommendations for the Lane County Tourism Special Project Grants?

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background

With approval of the Board in 1997, the grant application and awarding process for Special Project Tourism Grants was simplified. The new process has worked well with 119 grants awarded and \$669,700 disbursed for tourism promotion within Lane County over the last five rounds. Administrative time spent on the grant program has been reduced and grant appeals have been minimized. For the 2005 grant cycle (Round 15), we expect to disburse another \$132,000 in Special Project Tourism Grants.

Under the process each Board member is required to select a citizen from their district to serve on the grant advisory committee. The committee is responsible for:

- (1) Reviewing grant applications for completeness;
- (2) Evaluating how the proposed projects will contribute to increasing tourism;
- (3) Recommending the amount of grant funds that should be allocated to each grant applicant.

All recommendations are forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners for final approval. The person selected should have a broad understanding of the impacts of tourism, and be familiar with the County's tourism efforts and Yearly Marketing Plan. The anticipated term for each member is February 2, 2005 through December 31, 2005.

B. Analysis

It is very important for the citizen appointments to be made immediately, in order to keep the established timeline for awarding grants and executing contracts by March 31, 2005.

C. Alternatives/Options

Based on previous Board direction, each Board member should appoint a citizen from their district to serve on a committee to evaluate and recommend grant applicants for the Lane County Tourism Special Projects Grant Program.

D. Recommendations

Approve the attached Board Order.

E. Timing

Approval is needed immediately to avoid delays in awarding grants.
