Jim Goes, Ph.D. Addendum to Health Advisory Committee application

- Please see attached bio for background and experience. I have researched and taught in
 public health and health care management for fifteen years, and have published extensively
 in health services research. I am actively involved in community health planning and
 coordination efforts in Cottage Grove, in area schools, and in the Lane Coalition for Healthy
 Active Youth.
- 2. I have been involved in governance and advocacy in public schools for several years, and have developed a strong interest in child health, particularly around obesity. Over the last ten years I have worked both as a consultant and community member with community health coalitions in Alaska and Oregon, bringing my background and knowledge on interorganizational relations and partnerships to the public health field. I feel that I could make a contribution in terms of strategic thinking and planning, community health planning, and a good knowledge of public health issues. I am also greatly concerned about community members falling through the fraying safety net. I would like to help find ways county public health and community partners could be more efficient and effective with taxpayer dollars while widening access to citizens falling through the net.
- 3. See #2 above. I have a particular interest in childhood obesity, and the major implications it poses for demand and cost of public health services in the future. However I have an interest in a variety of public health issues.
- 4. I serve on the South Lane School Board (Cottage Grove), and in the leadership of the Lane Coalition for Active Healthy Youth (a grassroots community organization). I am participating in development of a community health partnership in Cottage Grove, and have worked as a consultant and volunteer with various community organizations in the county.
- 5. I have served on a variety of boards and committees over the years composed of diverse individuals, and work well with people of all kinds. I consult with organizations to identify and work effectively with individuals and groups who bring diverse cultural values to the workplace. My background in this area will add to the county effort on diversity.

Jim Goes is Managing Partner of Cybernos, LLC. He also serves as Adjunct Associate Professor of Management at the University of Oregon, and teaches strategic management in the Oregon Executive MBA program. His consulting focuses on strategic and business planning, health management and policy, public process facilitation, electronic commerce, and board development.

Jim brings a strong background and experience to his consulting work. He began his career in a Fortune 100 environment, returning to complete graduate studies in management.
