I. MOTION

TO APPROVE THE ORDER ACCEPTING PARCELS OF LAND TO BE USED AS A PUBLIC ROAD EASEMENT FOR THE REALIGNED SEGMENT OF AIRPORT ROAD AND GREEN HILL ROAD, FROM AIRPORT ACCESS ROAD SOUTHERLY AND WESTERLY ABOUT 0.95 MILES TO GREEN HILL ROAD, BEING SEGMENTS OF COUNTY ROAD NUMBERS 618, 465 AND 2258, AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THE FINAL ORDER, AND BEING IN TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, **RANGE** WEST. OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

II. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

A. Background / Analysis

Lane County, in cooperation with the cities of Eugene and Springfield, approved the Eugene Airport Master Plan Update by Ordinance PA 1145 on March 8, 2000. This included provisions for a new parallel runway at the Airport and also approved the realignment of Green Hill Road (County Road Number 2258), which was completed in 2001, as well as modifications to sections of Green Hill Road (County Road Number 465) and Airport Road (County Road Number 618).

The Surveyor's Office of the Department of Public Works has received a document from the City of Eugene dedicating a parcel of land as a public road easement for a segment of Airport Road and Green Hill Road that has been realigned and reconstructed under the direction and specifications of the Lane County Public Works Department. When construction of the road is completed, a Final Order of Alteration of Airport Road will be prepared and the public road dedication will be accepted as a County Road. A portion of the existing right of way of Airport Road that is no longer needed for roadway uses will be vacated as part of the Final Order of Alteration.

B. Recommendation

It is recommended by the Public Works Director that the Board approve the dedication and acceptance of this parcel of land from the City of Eugene for public road purposes. This action will allow the legal proceedings to continue in the alteration of Airport Road in the vicinity of the Eugene Airport.

If the Board of County Commissioners approves the order accepting the Dedication of Public Road Easement, it is to be entered in the records of the Board of County Commissioners Journal of Administration after which it is to be forwarded to the Lane County Recorder for filing and recording, after which copies are to be forwarded to the County Surveyor and County Assessor for appropriate action. If the acceptance is denied, an Order to Deny the Acceptance will be presented to the Board at a later regularly scheduled meeting.

DEDICATION OF A PUBLIC ROAD EASEMENT

CITY OF EUGENE, an Oregon municipal corporation, grants and dedicates to LANE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, GRANTEE, a public road easement on and over the following described properties:

A parcel of land lying in the Northwest one-quarter (NW 1/4) and the Northeast (NE 1/4) of Section 8, and the Southwest one-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 4 West, of the Willamette Meridian, Lane County, Oregon, and being a portion of those tracts of land conveyed to CITY OF EUGENE, by certain deeds recorded in Book 212, Pages 79-80; Reel 2082, Recorder's Reception Number 9541371; Reel 2174, Recorder's Reception Number 9632450 Reel 2221, Recorder's Reception Number 9666828; Reel 2598, in Recorder's Reception Number 99086512; Recorder's Reception Number 2005-022950; and Recorder's Reception Number 2005-083799, LANE COUNTY OREGON DEED RECORDS, said parcel being described in the following three (3) descriptions:
