I. MOTION

TO ACCEPT A DEED OF LAND TO BE USED AS PUBLIC AND COUNTY ROAD EASEMENT (CO. RD. NO. 2151, THIRD ST., AKA PIONEER PARKWAY EAST) AND TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S CONSENT TO ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD (MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PARKWAY AND THIRD ST.) (17-03-22 & 27)

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Board is being asked to accept a deed of county owned land to be used as public and county right of way for County Road No. 2151 (Third Street, also known as Pioneer Parkway East). In addition, the Board is being asked to authorize the County Administrator to consent to annexation of property to the City of Springfield.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

Both the Dedication and the Authorization of Consent to Annexation addressed in this proceeding are part of an eventual planned surrender of certain rights of way presently under county jurisdiction to the City of Springfield. The dedication and annexation must both necessarily be approved prior to the surrender. All portions of the rights of way included in these proceedings are located within the City of Springfield Urban Growth Boundary.

The Dedication portion of this proceeding (see Dedication Map attached as Attachment "A") consists of a parcel of county owned land which was acquired in 1973 by warranty deed recorded November 5, 1973 on Reel 663, Recorder's Reception No. 7350074, located in the vicinity of the intersection of Third Street and Hayden Bridge Way (County Road No. 667). It will be dedicated as part of County Road No. 2151 (established as Third Street, later named Pioneer Parkway East), which was established in 1979 by Board of County Commissioners Resolution and Final Order No. 79-5-23-3.

The Authorization of Consent to Annexation portion of this proceeding (see attached Petition for Annexation and Annexation Map labeled Exhibit "B") consists of a portion of right of way in the vicinity of the junction of Beltline Road, Game Farm Road and Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway; a portion of Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway from Game Farm road south to Hayden Bridge Way; and a portion of Third Street (Pioneer Parkway East) from Hayden Bridge Way south to the existing Springfield city limits at approximately the south boundary line of tax lot 1700 of Assessor's Map 17-03-27-11 in the vicinity of the intersection of Pioneer Parkway East and T Street.

The completion of this Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation will facilitate the subsequent surrender of these portions of right of way to the City of Springfield that are no longer required nor desirable as part of the county road system.

B. Policy Issues

Lane Manual 15.105 provides for the dedication and acceptance of right of way for public roads as authorized by ORS chapters 215 and 368. Lane Manual 15.200 provides for the acceptance of public road dedications as County Roads. The Dedication herein considered is within the scope of these guidelines. The Authorization of Consent to Annexation herein considered is consistent with the County/City Roads Partnership Program Agreement of July, 2004. The Public's interest was determined to be benefited when this agreement was reached

C. Board Goals

Part of Lane County's Strategic Plan is to contribute to appropriate community development in the area of transportation and land development (Lane County Strategic Plan, Goals, P. 13). The Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation herein considered will facilitate the subsequent surrender of these portions of right of way to the City of Springfield, which in turn will allow incorporation of these rights of way into the City of Springfield's transportation system.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

The Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation herein considered will facilitate the subsequent surrender of portions of right of way to the City of Springfield, which in turn will reduce County maintenance expenses and liabilities in a time when the continuation of federal payments that benefit the County's Road Fund are in jeopardy.

IV. ANALYSIS

All portions of the rights of way included in these proceedings are located within the City of Springfield Urban Growth Boundary. The Dedication of a parcel of county owned land as part of County Road No. 2151 as shown in Dedication Map Attachment "A", along with the Authorization of Consent to Annexation of the portions of right of way as shown in Annexation Map Exhibit "B" will facilitate the subsequent surrender of said rights of way to the City of Springfield. These actions are consistent with Lane County policies and governing statutes, and will be of benefit to the public by allowing for the ultimate transfer of these rights of way to the City of Springfield for incorporation into their transportation system, and will allow the City to maintain, develop and improve these roads, as needed, to the City's specifications, standards and timetable.

V. ALTERNATIVES/OPTIONS

The Board of County Commissioners has the option to:

- 1. Approve the Order of Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation as presented herein.
- 2. Deny the Order of Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation as presented herein.
- 3. Continue the matter for further consideration.

VI. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

Timing of this matter is important in order to facilitate the timely annexation and surrender of the rights of way considered herein.

VII. RECOMMENDATION

The Surveyor's Office recommends approval of the Order of Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation as presented herein and shown on Dedication Map Attachment "A" and Annexation Map Exhibit "B". Approval of these actions will facilitate the subsequent surrender of these rights of way to the City of Springfield. It will be in the public interest that the City of Springfield have jurisdiction over these rights of way to maintain, develop and improve these roads, as needed, to the City's specifications, standards and timetable.

VIII. FOLLOW-UP

If the Board of County Commissioners approves the Order of Dedication and Authorization of Consent to Annexation, it is to be forwarded to the Lane County Clerk. The County Clerk shall file the Final Order in the Commissioner's Journal of Administration

and forward copies to the Lane County Surveyor and the Department of Public Works Director for updating appropriate indexes and County Road Records. If the Order is not approved, an Order to Deny will be presented to the Board at a later regularly scheduled meeting.

DEDICATION OF A PUBLIC ROAD EASEMENT

LANE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, GRANTOR, grants and dedicates to the PUBLIC for public and County Road purposes, and expressly as a portion of County Road Number 2151 (Pioneer Parkway East, originally established as Third Street), a public road easement on and over the following described property:

A parcel of land lying in the Southeast one-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 22 and the Northeast one-quarter (NE ¼) of Section 27, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, of the Willamette Meridian, Lane County, Oregon, and being a portion of that tract of land conveyed to LANE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, by that certain deed recorded November 5, 1973, on Reel 663, Recorder's Reception Number 7350074, LANE COUNTY OREGON DEED RECORDS, said parcel being described as follows:

"Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the Easterly right of way of the Southern Pacific Company's Harrisburg Branch and the North line of the Jacob Halstead Donation Land Claim No. 47 in Township 17 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian and running thence South 89°50' East 150.0 feet along said North line; thence South 0°17' West 591.3 feet to a point in the Easterly right of way of said Railroad; thence North 13°56' West 609.65 feet to the point of beginning, said point of beginning being 3187.95 feet North and 3102.8 feet West of the Southeast corner of said Donation Land Claim, containing 1.0 acres, more of less, in Lane County, Oregon", except that portion lying within the right of way of County Road Number 667 (Hayden Bridge Way), also except that portion lying within the right of way of County Road Number 2151 (Pioneer Parkway East, which was established as Third Street).

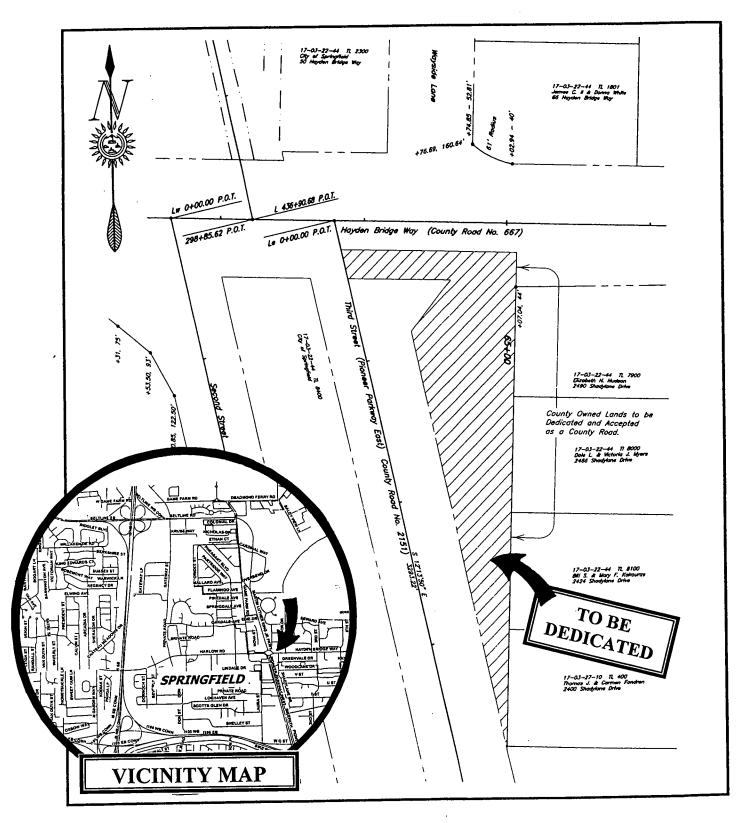

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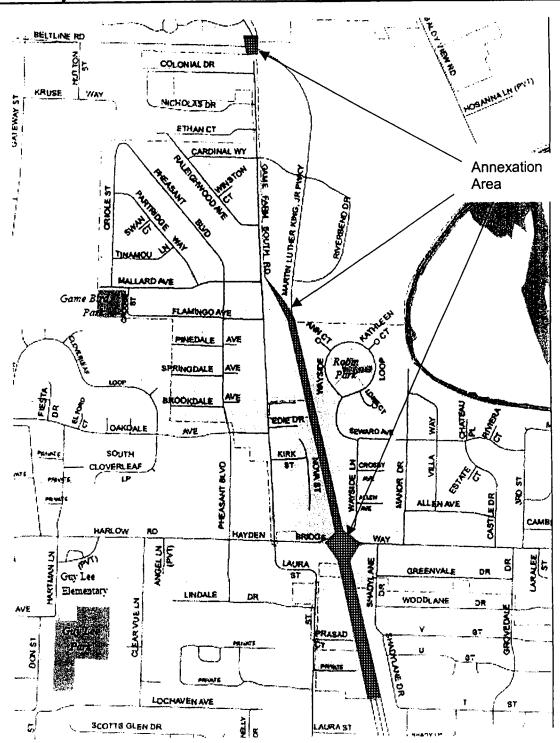


EXHIBIT B ANNEXATION MAP
