I. MOTION

TO APPROVE THE ORDER ACCEPTING EASEMENTS TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC ROAD PURPOSES FOR HAYES LANE (COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 839), IN SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

II. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

A. Background / Analysis

Hayes Lane (County Road 839) was established as a 40 foot wide County Road in 1918 and is currently a 1.75 mile long rural local road connecting to River Road. The preservation of the road, including the acquisition of permanent road easements, was determined to be needed by the County Engineer. The project was approved for funding through the adoption of the FY 06/07 through FY 10/11 Capital Improvement Program by Order No. 06-5-3-8 and as a County Force Project by Public Works Road Maintenance Division.

Lane County acquired a permanent road easement through deeds recorded in Lane County Deeds and Records and created a map depicting the acquisitions contained in the project files located at the Public Works Engineering Department.

The Surveyor's Office has received a request from the Right of Way Management program of the Department of Public Works to accept deeds for land as a public road easement for County Road Number 839 (Hayes Lane).

The project appears to be consistent with Lane Code Chapter 15 which provides for improvement, development or redevelopment of County Roads in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan.

B. Recommendation

It is recommended by the Director of Public Works that the Board support approving the Order to accept deeds of land for Hayes Lane for public road purposes and as County Road.

C. Follow-up

If approved, it will to be entered in the records of the Board of County Commissioners Journal of Administration after which it will to be forwarded to the Lane County Recorder for filing and recording, after which copies will be forwarded to the County Surveyor and County Assessor for appropriate action
