AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY:

The Board of Property Tax Appeals is responsible for hearing taxpayer petitions for the reduction of the assessed value or specially assessed value of property as of January 1 or as determined under ORS 308.146 (6)(a) or 308.428; the reduction of real market value of property as of January 1 or as determined under ORS 308.146 (6)(a) or 308.428; the reduction of maximum assessed value of property as of January 1 or as determined under ORS 308.146 (5)(a) and 308.428; and corrections to value made under ORS 311.208. The board hears petitions for the reduction of value as provided above, but only if the value that is the subject of the petition was added to the roll prior to December 1 of the tax year. The board shall consider applications to waive liability for all or a portion of the penalty imposed under ORS 308.295 or 308.296.

The Board of Property Tax Appeals shall consist of those persons selected by the County Clerk from the pool of board members appointed under ORS 309.067. The board shall consist of one member of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (a) and two members of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (b). The term of each member begins on the date of appointment, and shall end on June 30 following appointment or when the member resigns or is replaced. Any non-office holding Lane County resident appointed to the pool may serve on any board as needed for the efficient conduct of business. All persons appointed as members of a pool must complete training approved by the Department of Revenue for the term of appointment. Members shall be compensated for their expenses in the manner provided in ORS 309.022 (2). The per diem rate is \$12.50 per hour. Each board shall consist of one chair and two other members selected from the appointed pools.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Pursuant to ORS 309.067 (5), on or before October 15 of each year the Lane County Board of Commissioners shall appoint two pools of board members who may be selected by the County Clerk to sit on the Board of Property Tax Appeals. The County Clerk may select additional boards, if necessary, for the efficient conduct of business. Each board shall consist of one non office holding resident member of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (a) representing the Board of Commissioners, and two members of the pool described in ORS 309.067 (1) (b), representing non-office holding residents of Lane County who are not employees of the county or of any taxing district within the county.





Sally Smith Application for 2007 BOPTA service

1. I have received the required State of Oregon training three times and served on the board for the past four years (2003-04-05-06). The first year I had limited service but the past two years I served as a full-time member of the residential board. I have brought to the board my sense of responsibility—always there and on time, staying as long and as late as deemed necessary to complete the work. I am willing to continue to offer my ability to listen carefully and question what I have heard. I took the overall responsibility of serving on the board very seriously. All of these traits are important to the workings of the board. I have learned well how the committee works, the laws that govern it, and know the people who are involved in the process. The past years I was the daily record keeper for the committee and proved to be 'almost' 100% accurate!

See answer to question 4 for a description of work experience that helps me qualify for service on BOPTA.

- 2. I appreciate the fact that people can come in front of and speak with a representative body that understands their situation and shows concern for them as citizens of Lane County. As a regular member of the committee this past year I tried to ask fair and appropriate questions for each of the different cases being heard. I did my homework for each day's hearings and tried hard to understand the conflicts involved. I have a strong interest, both personal and professional, in housing issues and used this knowledge to add insight and balance in the work of the committee. I think my personal manner usually works to help solve problems if / when they arise, but I also do not run away from a conflict if one is needed.
- 3. My concerns about the community are centered around meeting the basic need for safe, decent, sanitary housing for all with the responsibility of the County to assess property to raise the necessary taxes that support the works of the County. The disparity in peoples housing needs are great and the laws and procedures that allow for wide differentials in what people pay in property taxes continues to concern the board. After four years on the committee I realize that some people know the system quite well and tend to use it successfully. First timers come in, looking for help and justice. If appointed to the committee again I will continue seek the facts of the situation which will help us reach a fair decision
- 4. My housing-related credentials have proved helpful in my service on the board. As I have explained before, I worked in the administration of University Housing for twenty years, both in family housing and the residence halls. I was responsible for maintenance and improvements for the 95+ houses in east campus, and the two family housing complexes, Westmoreland and what was Amazon Village. Later I served as director of two residence hall complexes and served as assistant director of residence life. Before my service at the University, I worked as a housing consultant doing market studies of housing needs in various Oregon communities. I have been active in nonprofit housing for families and seniors, and was instrumental

in securing funding and building several housing projects for low and moderate income people using HUD programs. I served on the Eugene City Budget Committee for four years in the late 1970's and I continue to be involved in my neighborhood organization and work on its issues, many which have to do with housing . I also participate in the City Club of Eugene, Learning in Retirement, and serve as a guide at the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art and the Jacobs Gallery.

5. I am not sure if being a woman adds to the diversity on this board or not. I was one of two women out of eight board members who served this past year. I have often seen women appealers relax and do a good job of presenting their case. Perhaps I helped them see that the process would be open and fair.

My interest in the work of the board remains strong and I will be honored if I am allowed to serve another term.
