I. MOTION:

IT IS MOVED THAT RON KAUFMANN - BUILDER BE AWARDED A CONTRACT #08-C-0003 FOR LAURELWOOD COMMUNITY ROOM UPGRADE AND THAT AN ORDER TO THIS EFFECT BE SIGNED; AND AN AGREEMENT BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH BID DOCUMENTS.

II. ISSUE

Board approval is required to award a contract for Laurelwood Community Room Upgrade, located in Florence, Oregon .

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background:

The Agency is planning to accomplish comprehensive modernization of the Laurelwood Homes community room in Florence, Oregon. This project is the eleventh phase of modernization of Laurelwood Homes.

The work includes, but is not limited to: removal of existing roofing, siding, and windows, selective interior and exterior demolition, rough framing, finish carpentry; rigid and batt insulation; metal flashings; galvanized steel handrails; asphalt shingle roofing; aluminum gutters; vinyl windows; vinyl siding; fiberglass exterior doors, wood interior doors, door hardware; gypsum wall board finishes; vinyl floorings; ADA kitchen cabinets; countertops; foundation vents; plumbing and fixtures; toilet room and kitchen exhaust; electrical systems and lighting; electric heaters; fire alarm; and appliance installation.

B. Analysis

A formal bid process was issued by the Agency for the required work. Two bids were obtained, and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Ron Kaufman-Builder with a bid amount of \$149,200. They have reviewed their bid and confirmed their costs.

C. Alternatives/Options

In that the public bidding process was employed, the lowest bid has no irregularities and is responsive and responsible, the prices are considered competitive, and there are sufficient budget funds to cover the project, we recommend award of the contract to Ron Kaufmann - Builder.

D. Recommendation

Approval of the proposed Motion.

E. Timing

Upon bid award, the contractor shall have ten days to provide the Agency with a signed contract. It is anticipated that all other necessary documents could be processed by March 3, 2008 and work would commence shortly thereafter.
