#### II. **AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY**

Health & Human Services Developmental Disabilites Services staff propose Lane County to proclaim March 2008 as "Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month" to build community awareness by the recognition of the tremendous value and potential of children and adults with developmental disabilities.

#### III. **DISCUSSION**

### A. Background / Analysis

March, 2008 has been declared "Developmental Disabilties Awareness Month". Lane County Developmental Disabilities Services joins this recognition and asks the Commissioners to proclaim March, 2008 as Lane County Developmental Disabilites Awareness Month and to specifically designate March 5, 2008 as a day to recognize our community's children and adults with developmental disabilities and the tremendous value and potential they have to offer. Developmental Disabilties Services Program serves approximately 1,600 individuals with developmental disabilities by providing case management services, residential services including in-home care, foster care, and group home care, as well as vocational opportunities to encourage independence and productivity among this population while promoting the empowerment and inclusion of these individuals within our community.

## **B.** Alternatives / Options

- 1. To proclaim March, 2008 as "Developmental Disabilties Awareness Month." and to designate March 5, 2008 as a day to recognize our community's children and adults with developmental disabilities.
- 2. Not to proclaim March, 2008 as "Developmental Disabilties Awareness Month" and not to designate March 5, 2008 as a day to recognize our community's children and adults with developmental disabilities.
